Vacancies:

We are still looking for individuals to serve in our Vice President/Committee Chair position and our Secretary position. There has been no interest in either position despite several announcements.

Membership:

There are 58 members in the Delaware Association of School Librarians. Once school is back in session this August, efforts will be made to contact school librarians who are not members, particularly those in private and charter schools, to recruit them.

Advocacy:

Our postcard campaign through the DDL's Summer Reading program is underway. We should start receiving postcards back from libraries in transit to Salesianum in mid-August and the Executive Board will meet to sort those by district and school and then send them to the appropriate school's decision-maker.
