The Delaware Library Association concurs and supports the construction recommendations for September 2021 by the Delaware Council On Libraries for the following libraries. This list is presented in recommended priority order. Corbit-Calloway and Newark are equivalent in priority order; timelines for the projects are subject to change.

•	Selbyville Public Library, Sussex County	FY2023 Request \$1,906,720
	Additional funding for construction of a new 14,000 square foot library.	
•	Rehoboth Beach Public Library, Sussex County	FY2023 Request \$4,345,746
	Design and construction for renovation and addition to the existing library that will add 1,577 square feet, for a total of 13,519 square feet.	
•	N. Wilmington Library Campus, New Castle County	FY2023 Request \$6,000,000
	Needs assessment, site acquisition, design, and construction/ renovation for a 24,000 square foot library campus.	
•	Wilmington Institute Library, New Castle County	FY2023 Request \$286,000
	An elevator and atrium at the North Wilmington branch library to accommodate a second floor that is being added to the existing building that will double the existing square footage.	
•	Bridgeville Public Library, Sussex County	FY2023 Request \$80,000
	Renovation to address drainage issue, bring all doors into ADA compliance, replace flooring in staff area, install LED lighting, and upgrade parking area for outdoor programming and services.	
•	Corbit-Calloway Memorial Library, New Castle County	FY2023 Request \$150,000
	Needs assessment for a renovation or a renovation and addition.
