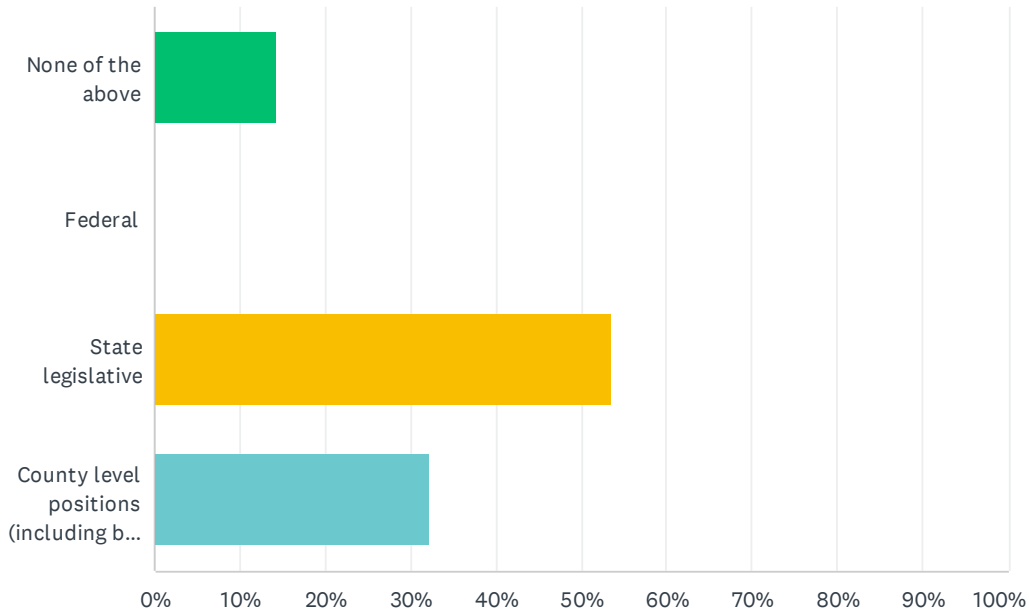


Q1 Which of the following public positions are you running for?

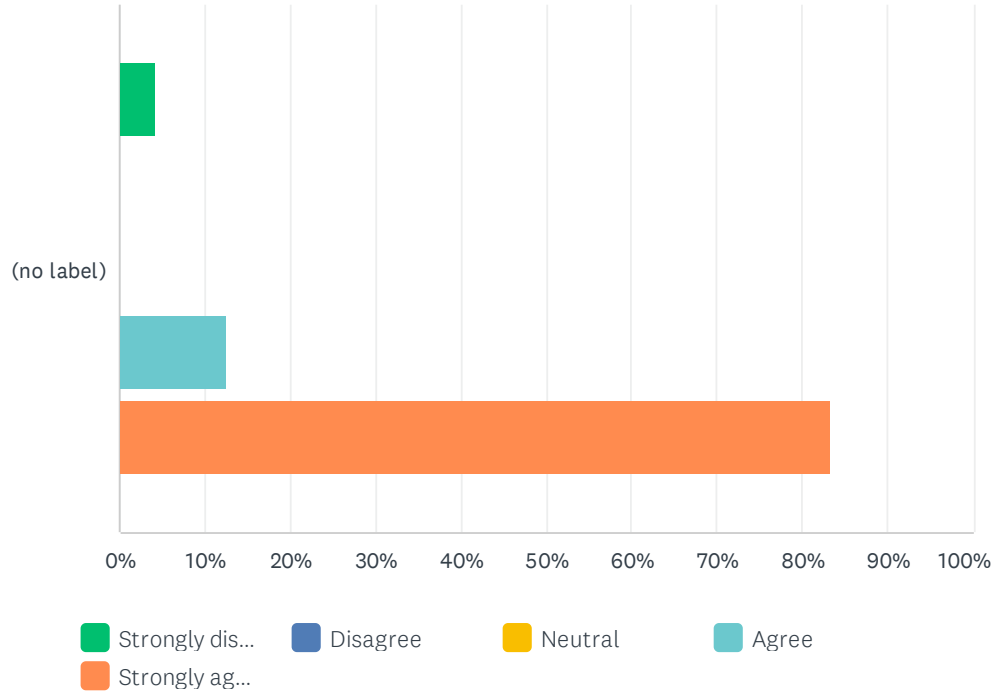

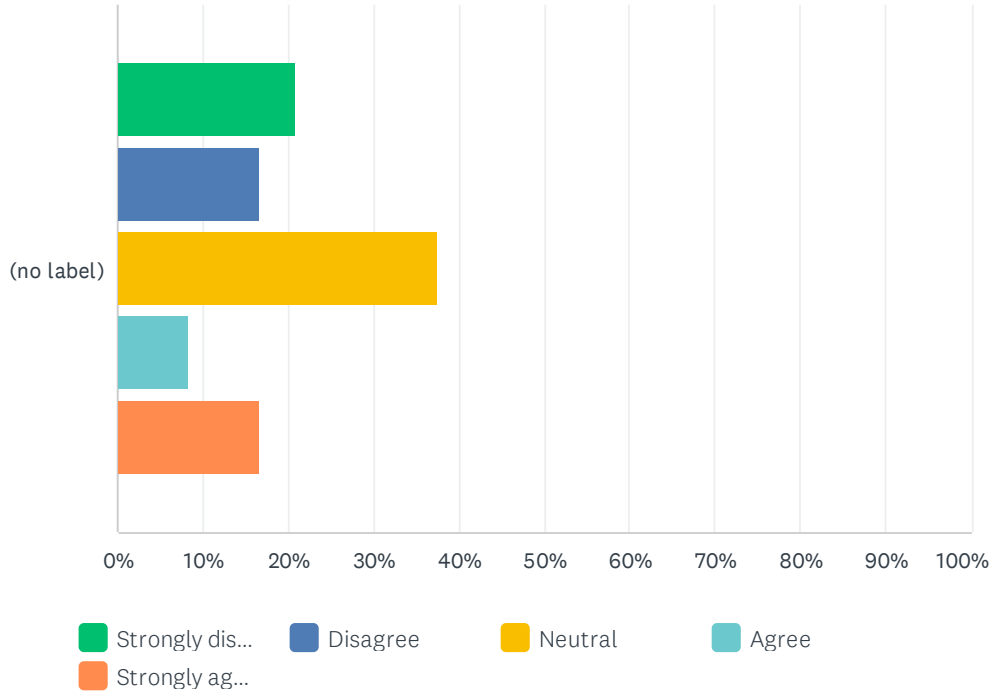

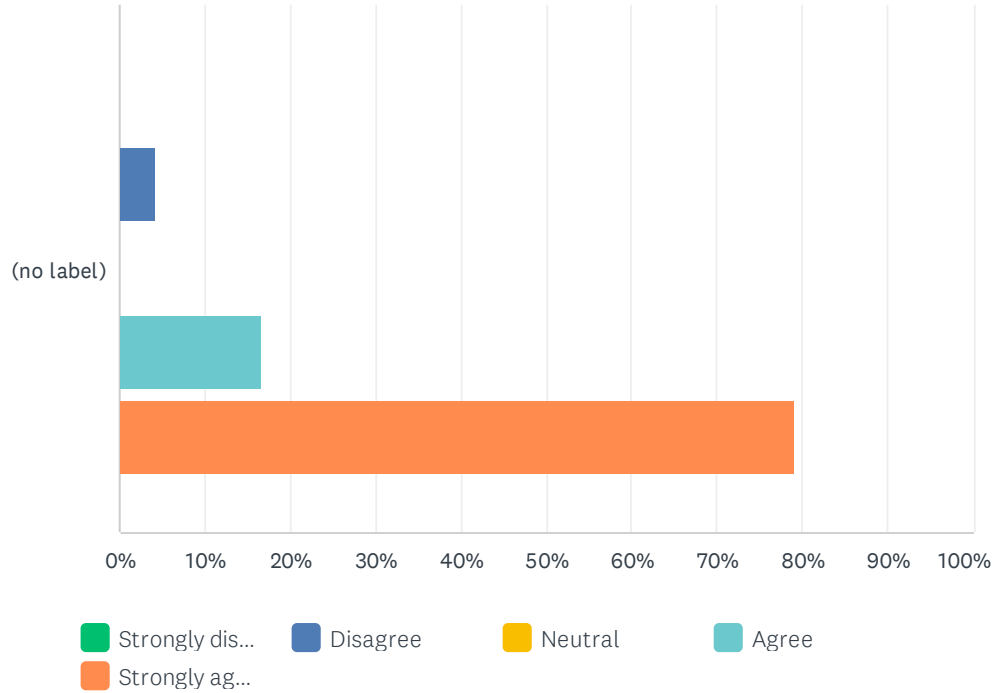

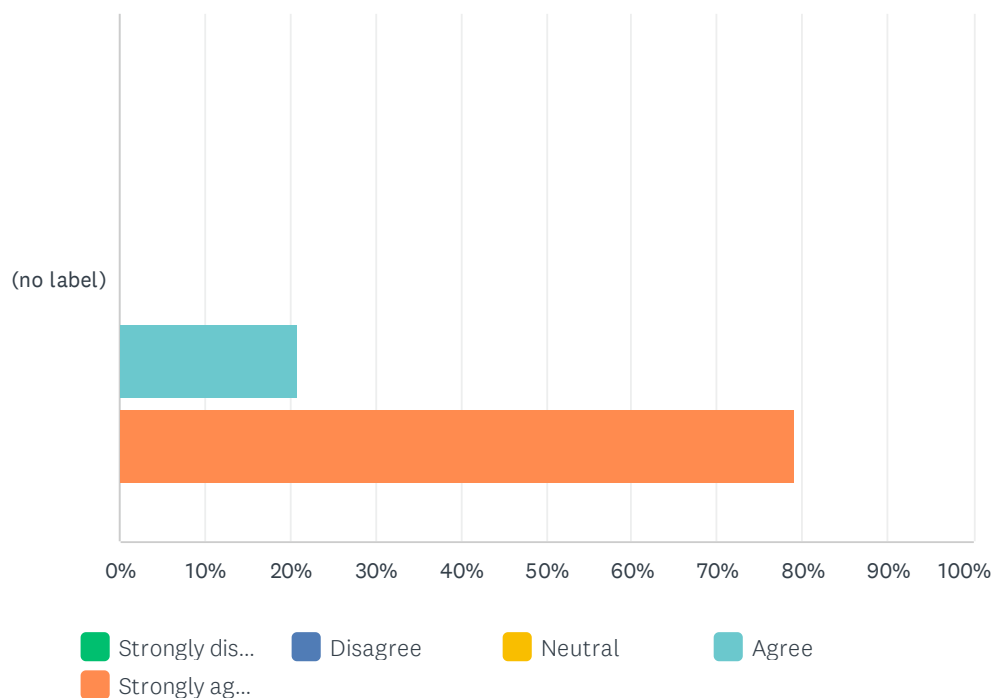

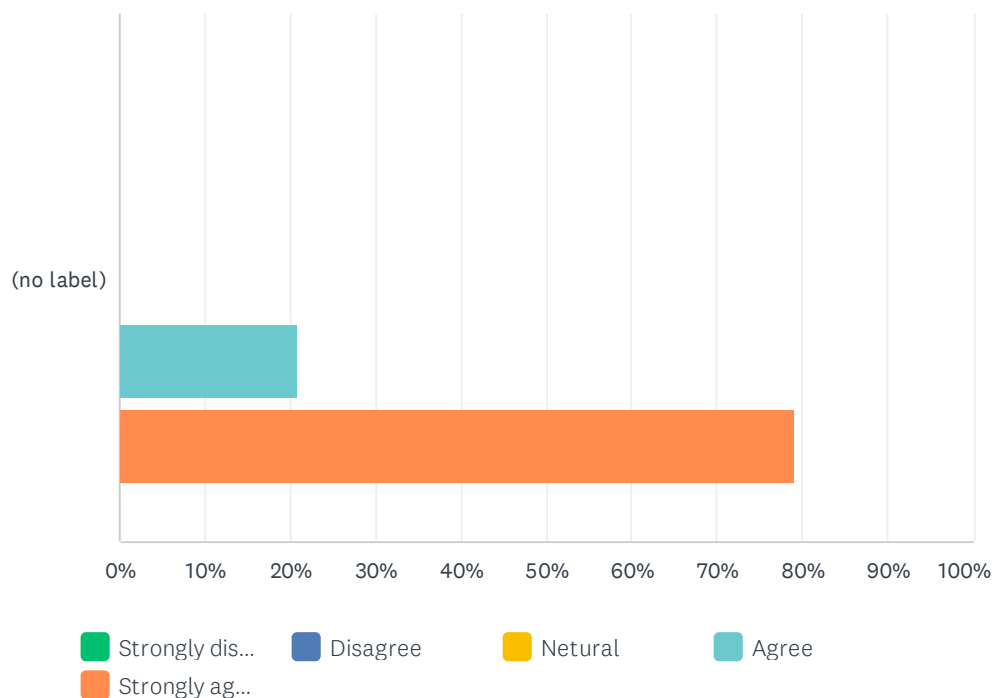

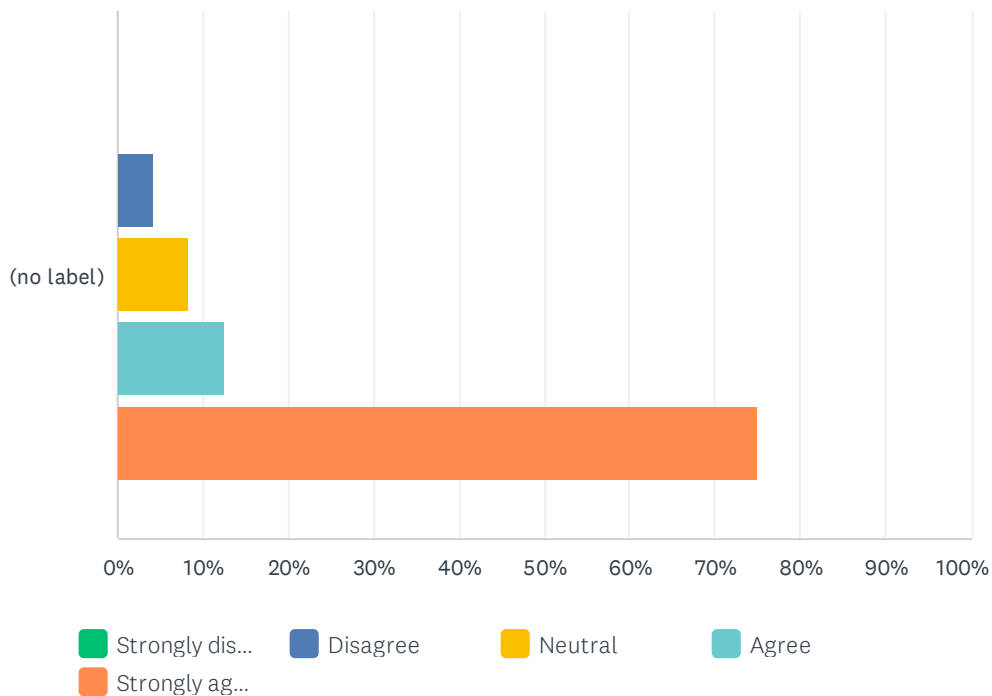

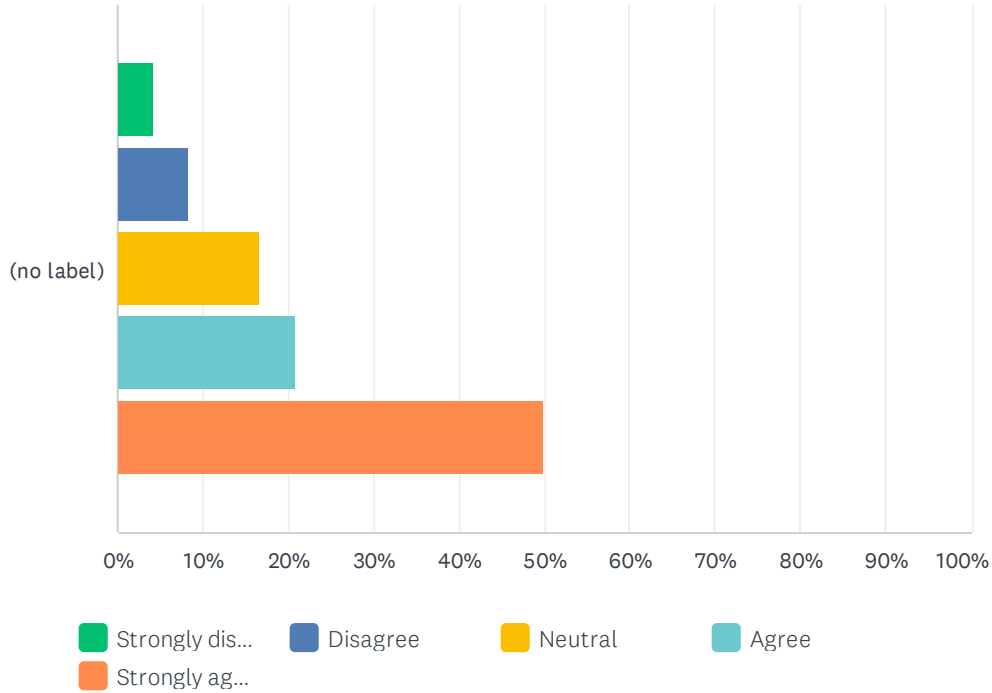

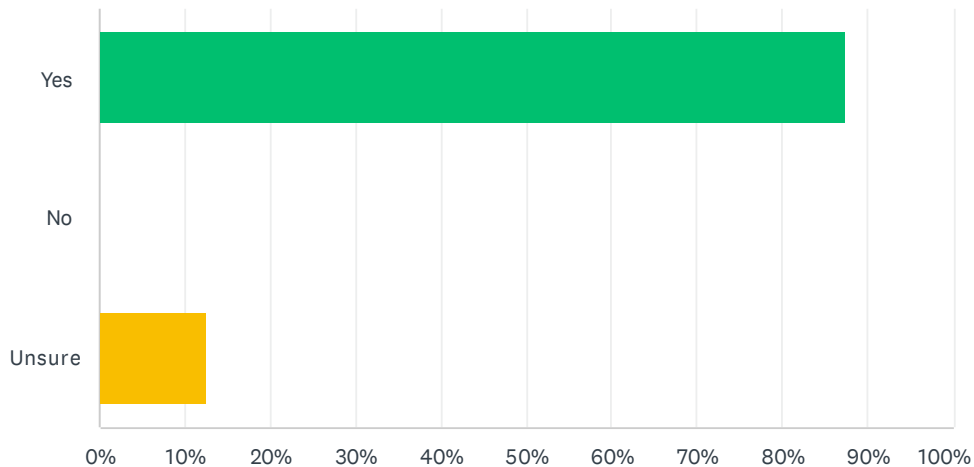

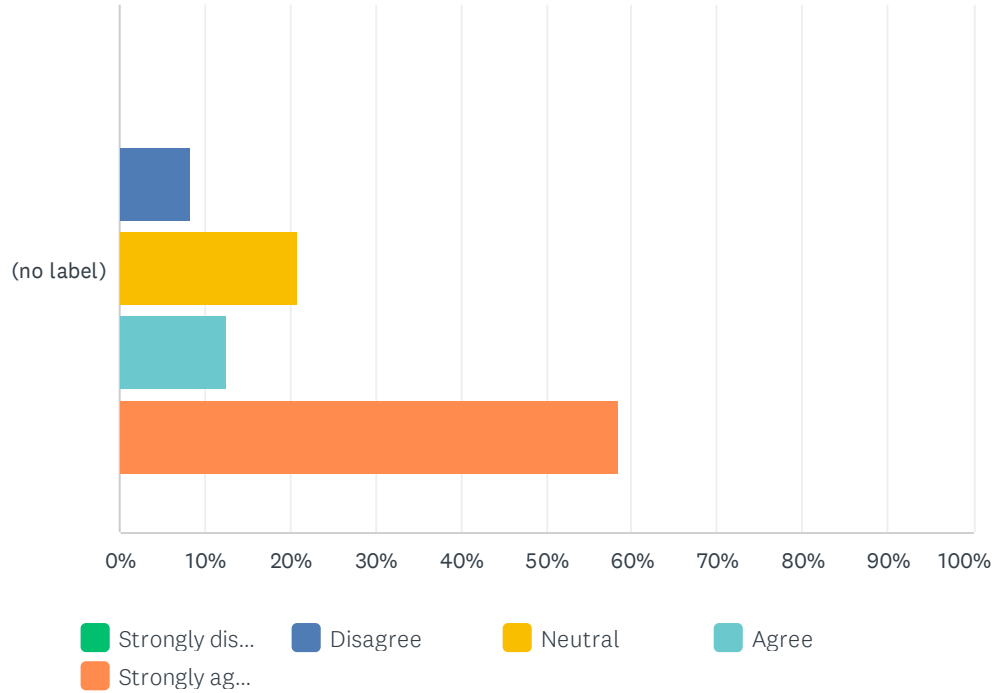

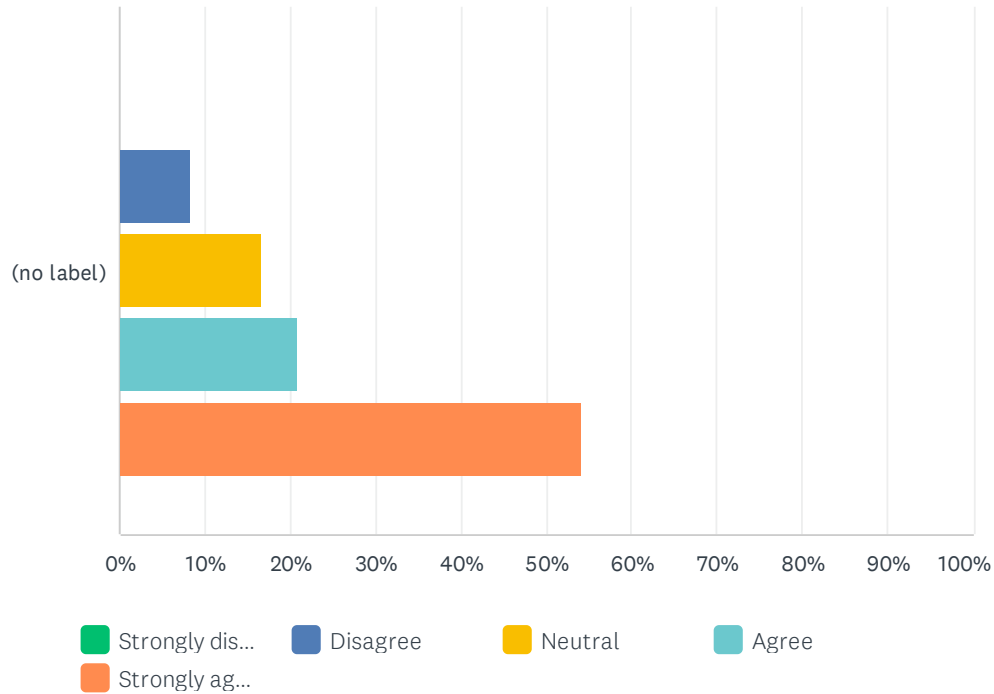

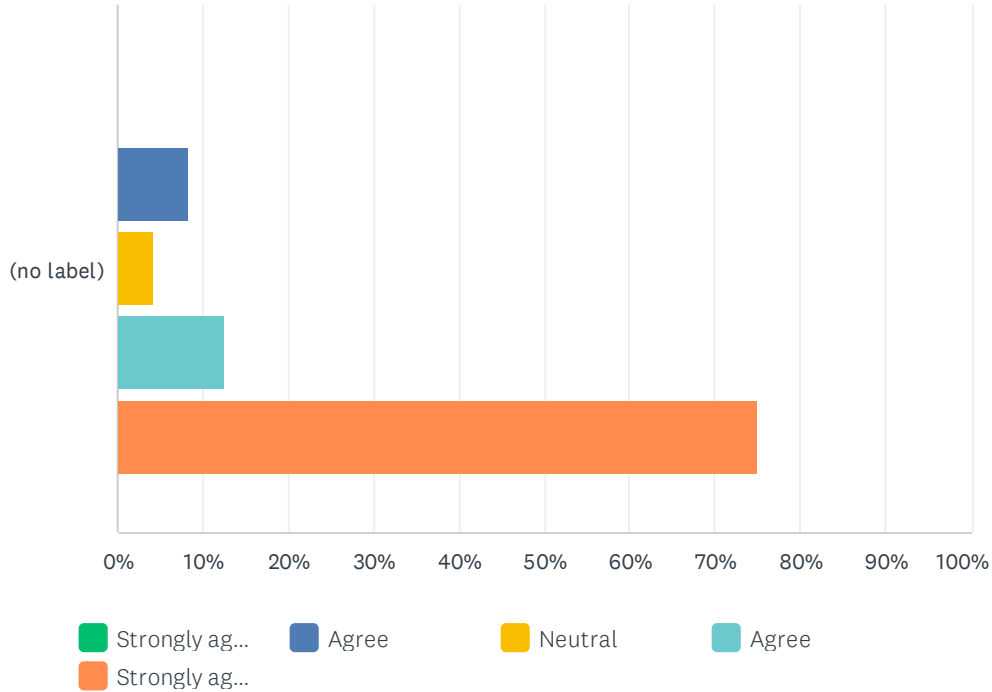
